

**SCHOOL BOARD
INTERNAL ORGANIZATION**

The Perry Board of Education is organized and operated under the laws of the State of Oklahoma. The board adopts the rules and regulations for the school, with executive and administrative authority delegated to the superintendent, the executive officer of the board. The board will meet after the annual election, the duly elected members will be qualified, and the board will be organized by electing its officers. The term of office of newly elected board members shall begin at the first regular, special, or emergency board meeting after the member has been certified as elected.

The board shall elect from its membership, at the first meeting, a president and vice-president, each of whom shall serve for a term of one year and until a successor is elected and qualified. The board shall also elect a clerk and, in its discretion, a deputy clerk, either of whom may be one of the members of the board, and each of whom shall hold office during the pleasure of the board and each of whom shall receive such compensation for services as the board may allow.

Board President

It will be the duty of the president to preside at all meetings of the board, to enforce rules, to sign warrants approved by the board, and to perform such duties as are required by law. The president of the board will have the authority to postpone the meeting to avoid conflicts with other important events.

Board Vice-president

It shall be the duty of the vice-president to perform all of the duties of the president in case of the president's absence or disability.
