

**SCHOOL COUNSELOR**

A counseling program is available to assist students, parents, and teachers develop positive learning experiences. The program is both comprehensive and developmental in nature. It consists of a variety of services including: individual and group counseling, classroom guidance, parent consultations, teacher consultations, coordination of student assessment, referral assistance, and other related guidance services.
