

TARDINESS

The Perry Board of Education believes that punctuality to assigned duties should be learned as early as possible. Therefore, student tardiness to any class is not permitted. A student is tardy if the student is not over the threshold when the bell rings. A student who is more than 15 minutes late for class will receive an absence for that class that day. All work assigned during that period will be due as assigned. Students who arrive late to class (less than 15 minutes) should be dealt with according to the tardy policy. On the 4th and subsequent tardy per semester the student will be given an unexcused absence, a detention, and, if during the second semester, the student will take the final. Students arriving after 15 minutes will be counted absent.
