

**OPERATING PRINCIPLES**

The Perry Board of Education establishes the following operating principles for the public schools in this district:

1. Facilitate a community process to identify competencies and skills expected for Perry Public Schools graduates with consideration given to competencies and skills identified by research and state and national organizations.
2. Facilitate a continuing system-wide plan for addressing facilities needs.
3. Develop decision-making processes that are as inclusive and broad based as is feasible.
4. Provide educational programs that meet the needs of individual students to include analysis of students at all quartiles to identify special learning needs and strategies.
5. Implement appropriate personnel policies that enhance educational programs for students.
6. Analyze the characteristics of Perry Public School students, the educational needs of the students, and the effectiveness of Perry Public School educational programs for the purpose of future planning.
