

**CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR THE BOARD OF EDUCATION**

At times the Perry Board of Education may need to employ the services of outside consultants. The kinds of assistance sought from consultants may include, but will not necessarily be limited to, conducting fact-finding studies, surveys, and research; providing counsel or services requiring special expertise; and assisting the board in developing policy and program recommendations. All consultants should be approved by the superintendent prior to invitation and arrangement for visitation. The board of education shall approve all consultant contracts.

No employment agreement or contract will be entered into with any person who has retired as an administrator with any school district for 2 years after the retirement date of such administrator. (Retirement date, for the purpose of this policy, is the last day the employee is required to be physically present on the job.) However, such administrator may be employed as a substitute teacher.

There are legal restrictions concerning the amount a retired administrator may earn
