

ADVISORY COMMITTEES

The Perry Board of Education may, from time to time, appoint private citizens as official Advisory Committees to the board. Any recommendations of such committees or council are advisory only and will not be binding upon the board of education. Following the completion of specific functions, the committees shall be dismissed. Advisory committees shall serve as a two-way channel of communication and shall have the following specific purposes:

1. To study questions concerning the Perry School District submitted to the committee by the board of education,
2. To assist interpreting public opinion, and
3. To assist the board in explaining issues and problems to the community.
