

**BOARD VOTING**

Votes on all motions and resolutions shall be by “yes”, “no”, “present” or “abstain”. A vote of “present” or “abstain” shall not be counted as either “yes” or “no”. However, in order for a motion to pass, “yes” votes must be made by a majority of the members present. No secret ballot shall be used.

Members shall vote individually, by voice vote, and the votes of the members shall be individually recorded.

Each member and officer shall have one vote. All motions shall be carried by a majority of the members present and voting, provided a quorum is present. A majority shall mean "more than half" of the votes cast.
