

ADMINISTRATION IN ABSENCE OF POLICY

Upon recommendation of the superintendent, the board of education may adopt general and personnel policies to serve as a basis for the administration of the school and as a guide to the superintendent and other employees in conducting their respective duties. The policies approved by the board will be in published form and available to employees, patrons, and the Department of Education.

In cases where action must be taken involving the operation of the school district and where no guidelines have been established by board policy, the superintendent will have the authority to act. In such cases, the superintendent shall use his/her own best judgment based on what he/she believes the policy would be if it existed. Such emergency policy decisions will be reported to the president as soon as practical and to the board at its next meeting. The board will then determine whether a permanent policy should be established.
