

SEVERE WINTER WEATHER PROCEDURES

In the event of severe winter weather conditions, the Perry Board of Education authorizes the superintendent or designee to:

- Cancel school day or district activities
- Delay school start times
- Delay morning school bus routes
- Start early, delay, or cancel afternoon school bus routes
- Dismiss school early

Notification

The public will be notified using the systems listed in CKAC-P1 Emergency Notification Procedures. Absent such announcements, the public should assume that school will be in session or no changes have been made.

If school is canceled because of winter weather conditions, the district will attempt to notify the public by 6:00 a.m.

Early Dismissal

Early dismissal is not common in Perry Public Schools because of the many schedules of working parents. Every effort will be made to keep a normal afternoon schedule. An early dismissal would only occur because of unusual circumstances. Early dismissal does not necessarily mean students will arrive home early because winter weather slows travel, so parents/guardians should make appropriate arrangements for their children’s supervision.
